



## FAQ'S

**Will performance times be posted in advance?** Yes. Performance times can be found by at [www.ms200south.org](http://www.ms200south.org) and on the Facebook page.

**What is the re-entry policy?** A no re-entry policy will be enforced starting at 5pm on Saturday, April 1<sup>st</sup>.

**Is there seating at the event? Will chairs be allowed?** Seating is very limited at the event but you are allowed to bring your own beach blankets, towels and LOW BACK, folding, camping or beach chairs that will be allowed in a designated "Chair Zone" area. Sorry, but NO poolside lounges, lazy boys, banquet or folding metal chairs or inflatable chairs or couches allowed.

**Where can I park? Is it free?** First-come, first-served public parking areas can be found by on the website at [www.ms200south.org](http://www.ms200south.org) Yes, Parking is free. Please plan to arrive early to avoid traffic delays.

Patrons who have Mobility Disabilities: All facilities at the site are accessible. A free Coast Transit Authority Park N Ride accessibility shuttle service is available from the CTA Gulfport Transit Center located on 15th street in downtown Gulfport, directly across from the Federal Courthouse. This service begins running a half hour before the published event opening time and runs continuously throughout the event times and stops a half hour after the published event closing times. Please plan to arrive early to avoid traffic delays Shuttles will drop off/pick up patrons at the Hwy 90 main pedestrian entrance to the event. Please plan to arrive early to avoid traffic delays.

**Can I bring my pet?** No, sorry. Only ADA companion animals allowed.

**Can I bring my children?** Yes – all ages welcome. Children over two years of age require a ticket. Baby strollers are allowed.

**Will there be ATMs on premises?** Yes, this is a cash only event.

**May I hand out flyers for my event?** No – sorry. Unauthorized vending or solicitation materials (handbills, flyers, beach balls, samples, etc.) are not allowed.

**What kind of ID do I need to purchase beer? What if my ID is expired?** Only valid (non-expired) government-issued photo IDs will be accepted.

**Will I be searched upon entry?** Festival security will search all persons and bags prior to entry. Please review the prohibited items list below if you aren't sure whether or not you can bring something.

**What if it rains?** This is a rain or shine event.

- This is a Cash Only Event. ATMs will be on-site
- Event is Rain or Shine
- Performance acts and times subject to change
- Camping / overnight stays are not permitted
- Modified or tampered with tickets and "Over 21" wristbands are null and void
- Smoking is permitted in designated areas only.

- Baby strollers
- Beach blankets, towels and LOW BACK, folding, camping or beach chairs that will be allowed in a designated "Chair Zone" area.
- Backpacks & purses (smaller than 20" x 15" x 9")
- Binoculars
- Bug spray (non-aerosol)
- Sunscreen (non-aerosol)
- Ear plugs
- Hats
- Mobile phones
- Smoking is permitted in designated areas only.

## NO

- Poolside lounges, lazy boys, banquet or folding metal chairs or inflatable chairs or couches allowed
- Aerosol containers, including sunscreen and personal beauty products
- Air horns and/or megaphones
- Outside Food and Beverages of any kind
- Animals (besides service animals)
- Any container of liquid other than 1 factory sealed bottle of water (2L)
- Any items that can be used as a means to disturb the peace, endanger the safety of others
- Bota bags
- Bicycles
- Cameras with detachable lenses
- Camping tents, canopies, or shade structures of any kind
- Chinese lanterns
- Coolers of any kind (besides those advanced for medical use)
- Drones or any other remote flying device
- Fake IDs
- Fireworks, sparklers, firecrackers, and/or incendiary or explosive devices of any kind
- Flags and/or flagpoles
- Focused light devices (including laser pointers)
- Framed backpacks
- Glass containers of any kind
- Hammocks
- Illegal or Illicit substances of any kind
- Kites
- Large bags, purses, or backpacks (larger than 20" x 15" x 9")
- Mace / pepper spray
- Marker pens or spray paint
- Musical instruments
- Professional audio recording equipment
- Tailgating, grilling, or BBQing equipment
- Scooters or personalized motorized vehicles (unless in accordance with ADA regulations)
- Selfie Sticks
- Skateboards, rollerblades, 'hoverboards'
- Sleeping bags
